WHEREAS, The Tribal Council has completed the annual budget process including review of financial needs and revenue projections for the next calendar year; and

WHEREAS, The Tribal Council has reviewed the proposed 2006 Tribal Budget with the reservation community by conducting district meetings and a general council meeting; and

WHEREAS, Tribal Enterprise dividends, revenues, timber stumpage and other sources set forth below are the minimum levels expected and Tribal revenue from the following sources is estimated for calendar year 2006:

BE IT RESOLVED, By the (23rd) Tribal Council of the Confederated Tribes of the Warm Springs Reservation of Oregon, pursuant to Article V, Section 1 (t), as amended, of the Tribal Constitution and By-Laws and Ordinance 67, that the foregoing budget is approved with an effective date of January 1, 2006; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the sum of \$20,974,000 is hereby appropriated for expenditure pursuant to the foregoing annual budget for the twelve month period January 1, 2006 through December 31, 2006 and the Secretary of Interior or his/her authorized representative is hereby requested to approve such budget; and

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BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Tribal Council herein appropriates (transfers to the General Fund) as a source of funds for this Budget \$500,000 of "Investment Income from Idle Cash" that has accumulated in the Retained Earnings of the Credit Enterprise; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, Pursuant to Resolution No. 7720 and Articles V and VI of the "Warm Springs Revenue Reserve Fund" policies, the Tribal Council further reserves the authority to appropriate \$2,000,000, or such amount as is required to maintain a General Fund Working Capital Reserve Balance of \$6,000,000, from current and accumulated prior year earnings from the "Revenue Reserve Fund" to be made available as a source of funds in this Tribal Budget; PROVIDED that the Secretary-Treasurer deems such withdrawal and use of funds necessary in order to maintain adequate working capital in the Tribes' General Fund; PROVIDED FURTHER that total Tribal Budget expenditures for 2006 shall not exceed the amount authorized by this Resolution; PROVIDED FURTHER that the Secretary-Treasurer shall promptly secure concurrence of the Tribal Council prior to such withdrawal; PROVIDED FURTHER that the Secretary-Treasurer shall, upon making a determination that adequate funds are available to meet all other Tribal obligations, notify the Tribal Council and take steps to reimburse into the "Revenue Reserve Fund" funds in the same amount as were withdrawn pursuant to this authority; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Tribal Council directs that the following budget and program designations shall be implemented as part of this resolution \$35,000 for Comp and Benefits personnel, \$25,000 for Governmental Affairs Political Contributions, \$65,000 for Tribal Enrollment and Payment System, \$36,000 for Chief Operations Officer Extra Ordinary Youth, \$172,464 for Public Safety Patrol Division overtime and Norcor juvenile detention billings, \$10,000 for Appeals Court subcontract, \$365,000 for General and Admin; employee COLA, annual audit, severance and transfers, \$173,141 to eliminate negative payrolls, \$834,000 for Warm Springs Ventures Enterprise, \$200,000 for High Lookee Lodge Enterprise, \$37,000 Capital Projects for Tribal Firewall and Separate Voice and Data Circuits; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That it is the direction of the 23rd Tribal Council that the Tribal Government organization improve efficiency through a continued gradual and permanent downsizing of Tribal Government operational costs to better match anticipated revenues with expenditures during the fiscal year 2006 and the Secretary-Treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to coordinate with the Chief Operations Officer to implement a permanent base budget reductions of Tribal Government program operations and services in an amount not less than \$1,985,093 no later than December 31, 2005 and a list of reductions will be provided to Tribal Council; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, The Tribes have been paying juvenile detention Norcor billings on behalf of the BIA's unfunded obligation and responsibility for the safe keeping of Tribal juveniles and \$150,000 has been approved in the 2006 budget resolution for payments to Norcor and the Tribes acknowledge that by paying this unfunded BIA obligation that the Tribes is in no way releasing the BIA from their legal, financial and trust responsibility; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Secretary-Treasurer of the Confederated Tribes of the Warm Springs Reservation of Oregon is hereby authorized to proceed with the expenditure of funds for the purposes and amounts indicated in the Budget; PROVIDED that all constitutional provisions are met; PROVIDED FURTHER that the Secretary-Treasurer is authorized, upon making a determination that sufficient revenues will not be available to fund all expenditures authorized in this Budget Resolution, to take all necessary action to ensure that actual expenditures do not exceed the amount of available funds.

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CERTIFICATION

The undersigned, as Secretary-Treasurer of the Confederated Tribes of the Warm Springs Reservation of Oregon, hereby certifies that the Tribal Council is composed of 11 members, of whom 10 constituting a quorum were present at a meeting thereof, duly and regularly called, noticed, and convened and held this 23rd day of November, 2005, and that the foregoing resolution was passed by the affirmative vote of 9 members, the chairman not voting, and that the said resolution has not been rescinded or amended in any way.
