- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the sum of \$ 23,115,636 is hereby appropriated for expenditure pursuant to the foregoing annual budget for the twelve month period January 1, 2000 through December 31, 2000 and the Secretary of Interior or his/her authorized representative is hereby requested to approve such budget; and,
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the appropriated funds for non-capitalized programs shall be eligible for expenditure for a period not to exceed 2 calendar years and that the appropriated funds for capitalized items and projects shall be eligible for expenditure until the projects are completed; and,
