WHEREAS, Considerable community involvement has been utilized in the annual budget process, including a series of four budget workshops, nine district meetings, and two general council meetings; and

WHEREAS, The following proposed budget was posted on October 1, 1992 in three public places on the reservation for not less than thirty days; and

WHEREAS, The amounts reflected in the following appropriated budget will serve the needs of the Confederated Tribes of Warm Springs for calendar year 1993; now, therefore
